Arena 1 – 0900 hours start –

Open to all serving members of HM Forces (including Reservists, Police Forces and Prison Services), their dependants and members of Military Saddle Clubs.

To be judged under British Show Jumping Association (BSJA) Rules.

- Class A **RESTRICTED 1.00M**
The Anne Jeremiah Valentine Challenge Cup
Two-phase competition for horses and ponies that have not been placed in the Queen's Cup or King's Cup at the Royal Tournament and are not BSJA Grade A, B or JA. Limited to 2 horses/ponies per rider.
Speed: 325 metres per minute.
Entry: £10 per horse/pony
Prizes: 1st to 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class B **OPEN 1.10M**
The Aldershot Show Gymkhana Victor Ludorum Cup
Two-Phase.
Open to any horse/pony/rider combination. Limited to 2 horses/ponies per rider.
Speed: 350 metres per minute
Entry: £10 per horse/pony
Prizes: 1st – 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class C **OPEN TEAM COMPETITION**
The Bernard Wetherall Challenge Cup
Teams of 4 competitors, 3 scores to count.
Single round of 10 jumps maximum to include 2 doubles. In the event of equality of scores a second round of fences will be jumped by a nominated competitor against the clock.
Riders may compete in only one team.
Maximum height of fences to be 1.05m
Each team must nominate a Team Captain to be declared upon team entry. Teams will compete in a drawn order which will be displayed in the Steward's Tent.
Speed: 350 metres per minute.
Entry: £20 per team
Prizes: 1st – 6th. Rosettes to 6th place

SATURDAY, 2nd May - Services and Police Show Jumping

Arena 2 – 0830 hours start –

Open to all serving members of HM Forces (including Reservists, Police Forces and Prison Services), their dependants and members of Military Saddle Clubs.

To be judged under British Show Jumping Association (BSJA) Rules.

- CLEAR ROUND** Course may be altered by competitors to **any height**.
0830-1000 hrs *Entry:* £4 per round payable at the collecting ring gate.
- Class D **SMALL NOVICE – 70cm.**
For horses and ponies **not** affiliated to the BSJA or BE who have never won a show jumping class. To be judged under BSJA rules.
Table A Two Phase
Speed: 325 metres per minute
Entry: £10 per horse/pony
Prizes: 1st – 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class E **SMALL . INTERMEDIATE – 80cm**
Open to horses and ponies. For horses and ponies **not** affiliated to the BSJA or BE. To be judged under BSJA rules.
Speed: 325 metres per minute
Entry: £10 per horse/pony
Prizes: 1st – 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class F **SMALL OPEN - 90cm**
Open to any horse/pony/rider combination. To be judged under BSJA Rules.
Speed: 325 metres per minute.
Entry: £10 per horse
Prizes: 1st – 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class G **TOPSCORE WITH JOKER**
The Aldershot Command Challenge Plate
Open to any horse/pony/rider combination.
Fences from approximately 90cm to 1.10m, height of joker to be determined by judges/course builder.
Entry: £10 per horse/pony
Prizes: 1st to 6th. Rosettes to 6th place.

2 runs per competitor.
Entry: £10; Prizes: 1st to 6th; Rosettes: 1st – 6th
- Class J **RING AND PEG WITH SWORD AND LANCE**
The Wilkinson Sword
One run with each weapon.
Entry: £10; Prizes: 1st to 6th; Rosettes: 1st – 6th
- Class K **SWORD, LANCE AND REVOLVER**
The Priestley Cooper Cup
2 runs per competitor, the first without weapons (Practice).
Entry: £10; Prizes: 1st to 6th; Rosettes: 1st – 6th
Top 8 will qualify for Royal Windsor Horse Show
- Class L **TEAM TENT PEGGING WITH LANCE AND SWORD**
The Hugh Winter Cup
3 members per team, 1 run for each weapon,
all scores to count.
Entry: £20 per team Prizes: 1st to 6th; Rosettes: 1st – 6th
- THE SERVICES AND POLICE MASTER AT ARMS**
Aldershot Chamber of Commerce Cup
Rosettes: Master at Arms will be presented to the competitor
who gains the most points from classes H, J and K.
Prize for the highest placed newcomer

ALDERSHOT HORSE SHOW AT TWESELDOWN 2009
SERVICES AND POLICE EVENTS
GENERAL RULES – QUALIFICATIONS

1. **Eligibility.** Classes are open to all regular and reserve forces personnel, including the Police Forces and their dependants and members of Army, RAF and RN/RM Saddle Clubs. Serving competitors are to jump in No 2 dress or equivalent. Civilians must be appropriately dressed. ALL Members of the BTA (British Tent Pegging Association) are eligible for the Skill At Arms Classes
2. **Paying of Compliments.** Compliments are only to be paid to the Judges during Class C.
3. **Safety of Competitors and Horses.** Commanding Officers, Riding Masters and Instructors are responsible for ensuring that horse and rider combinations are safe and capable of competing within the class that they have been entered. The Ground Jury reserves the right to ask a competitor to leave the arena if they consider that it is in the best interest of the horse and rider.
4. **Collecting Ring Safety.** A Collecting Ring Steward will control the collecting ring and riders are only to enter the collecting ring when they have 10 competitors before they are to compete. Any other rider entering the collecting ring may be asked to leave. No horse may be held within the collecting arena and riders are to keep moving around and are not to use the collecting ring as a viewing area. Riders may be asked to enter the arena before the previous competitor has completed their round and should follow the instruction of the Collecting Ring Steward and avoid the other competitor. Any horse and rider combination that is not ready to compete at the declared time, will forfeit their opportunity to compete, except where assistance from a veterinary officer or a farrier is being sought.
5. **Passport and Vaccinations.** In accordance with BSJA and DEFRA Regulations, all horses are to have a passport, which could be examined by a Veterinary Officer on the day of the show. All horses are to be vaccinated against Equine Influenza within a 12-month period of the date of the show in accordance with BSJA Regulations. Any horse found to be in breach of any of these regulations may be refused entry to the showground.
6. All privately owned horses are to be insured to cover 3rd person liability. A copy of this cover must be brought to the show.
7. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
8. Show jumping classes will be run under the Rules of the British Show Jumping Association.

TIMINGS

9. Course walk commences at 0815 hrs, first competitor at 0900hrs prompt. In the first class, the riders will compete in a drawn order, which will be displayed in the Steward's Tent by 1800 hrs on the previous day.
10. Class C will not start before 1330 hours.
11. All timings are approximate.
